MODEL

The Lord placed deep in the heart of Vickie Poulson a vision of the **Jeremiah House**. Vickie visualized a home where a woman could find hope and realize her own potential for a bright and prosperous future.



Jeremiah House, currently an outreach of Soul Purpose Ministries, Inc. (501c3), is a non-profit organization reflecting Vickie's heart for those struggling with addictions, habits or hang-ups.



- Offers up to 24 months residence in the program. The goal is continuing sobriety, employment, and permanent housing upon graduation.
- Residents contribute to their living costs by cash or in-kind donation of volunteer hours in our community work programs and our social enterprises. There is no charge to enter the program.
- Jeremiah House provides a safety net, along with community providers for medical, addiction, and mental health treatment.
- Community resources are utilized to evaluate vocation/educational needs and to provide a computer literacy class within the first 30 days.
- Funding streams for the ministry include contributions from individuals, churches, businesses, and organizations, grants, fundraisers, social enterprises and work programs.
- Staff and volunteers demonstrate the love of Christ, by offering opportunities to participate in Christian worship and study. However, participation is not a requirement.
- Residents live in community, with those further along in recovery walking beside those who are new.
- Residents live together by the principal Love Heals: and Love never fails. (1 Corinthians 13:8)
- Residents work out conflicts in regular meetings facilitated by staff.
- Jeremiah House offers radical hospitality and love to residents by not having live-in staff, which allows the women to take some control over their lives and claim the place where they live as their home.
- Weekly stipends are provided for residents for the first 60 to 90 days.
- Authority is embedded in concepts of community and home, and in 12-step traditions. In learning to love, each woman allows herself to BE loved.
- In-house group services include health and wellness, recovery, computer literacy, financial literacy, and arts.
- Through working in community work programs and social enterprises of Jeremiah House, residents learn job skills and contribute to the community.
